Cosi is a funny, heart-warming Australian play by Louis Nowra, set in the radical 1970s. It places a new director in a position where he is coerced into directing a motley group of mental health patients into performing an opera by Mozart. The major problem is no one can sing or speak Italian.

Cosi is both funny and dramatic in turn - it is an insightful look at attitudes to mental health and the way we viewed the Vietnam War. It was a major Australian film in the 1990s featuring Toni Collette and Ben Mendelsohn - how young they look! The cast are going great guns at rehearsals and can promise a terrific show. 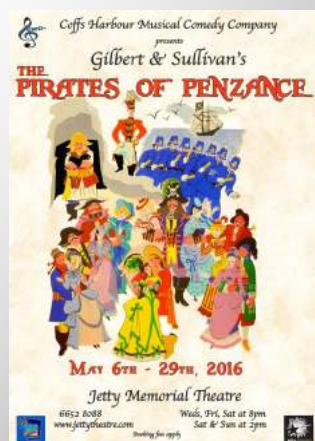
Last but not least we are still looking for directors with a play to fill next year's program. So don't be shy – if you are a director or budding director please contact me. All submissions will be considered.
