
Rex and David finally managed to make the hard decisions and finalise their selection - you can read who got which parts in Rex's report on the next page.

### PLAYS FOR 2016


Choosing which plays to perform is always a difficult task. CHATS' policy is always to try to do at least one comedy, one drama or classic and one Australian work every season.
